

Student Guide: Using EdPuzzle

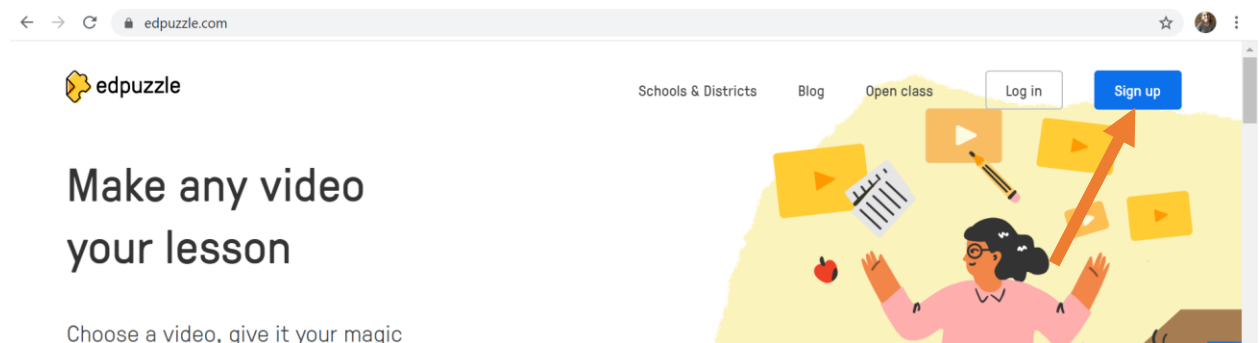

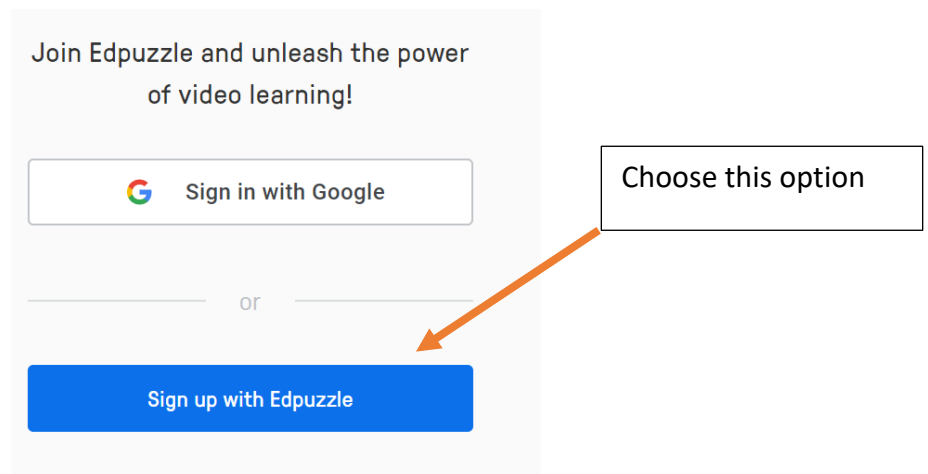
What is edpuzzle? Edpuzzle is a website that lets you watch a video assigned by your teacher and answer questions as you go. This is really nice because it prevents you from having to watch something and then track down the answers to questions later.

Step 1: Creating an account

1. Go to www.edpuzzle.com
2. Press the blue “Sign up” button in the upper right corner. Then choose “I’m a student”.



3. Click the “sign up with edpuzzle” option to create your account.



- Next, it will ask you to enter a *class code*. Your teacher should give you a six-letter code that allows you to join their class. If you do not know the code, ask your teacher!
- Enter your username and last name information. **IMPORTANT!** Keep in mind that your teachers can see your first name, last name, and username. Make sure to use your real name so teachers know who you are. I recommend using your student number as your username.
